This error message indicates that there are file access restrictions preventing a program from accessing a system file. In the Windows environment, this issue can occur due to various reasons such as permission settings, antivirus software, or file encryption. This article aims to provide instructions on resolving this error specifically for Windows users.

Examples:

1. Check File Permissions:

- Right-click on the file or folder causing the error and select "Properties."
- Go to the "Security" tab and click on "Edit" to modify the permissions.
- Ensure that the user account or group needing access has the necessary permissions (e.g., "Full Control" or "Modify").
- If the desired account or group is not listed, click on "Add" to add it and assign the appropriate permissions.

2. Disable Antivirus Software:
