 - Open Command Prompt as an administrator.
 - Type the following command and press Enter:

```
wbadmin start recovery -version:01/01/2022-12:00 -itemType:Volu
me -items:C: -quiet
```

• This command will restore the system image backup created on January 1, 2022, at 12:00 PM to the C: drive.
