How to Cut Videos in VLC Media Player for Windows

- 9. Save the cut video: Once the video stops playing, go to "Media" in the menu bar, select "Convert/Save," and choose a destination folder and filename for the cut video. Click "Save" to start the conversion process. VLC Media Player will create a new video file with the trimmed section.
